



## 2017 FLY RACING / ASCS CONTINGENCY PROGRAM

It pays to FLY in FLY RACING Gear! FLY Racing is proud to support the ASCS for 2017. Fly Racing supports local racing through the FLY Racer Contingency Program and your local motorcycle dealer! Check out the great benefits available for registered racers.

2017 Race ASCS race dates can be found on the series web page. Please note you must register before 50% of the series provided races are over to qualify for payout.

### How to get Registered

1. Rider must purchase (1) complete set of pants, jersey, and glove from the 2017 FLY Racing Line . 2017 FLY Racing Line consists of : Evolution Gear, Kinetic Gear and Lite Hydrogen Gear in either Adult or Youth sizes. Patrol & F-16 will not be apart of the program as it is for recreational use, not competition.

Purchases are to be from any FLY retailer. Must provide original purchased receipt containing purchase of jersey, pant & gloves.

2. Rider completes the Contingency Registration Form in full, along with your original receipt to FLY Racing/ASCS Contingency Program, attention Rider Support at 601 E. Gowen Rd., Boise, ID 83716. Form and receipt can also be emailed to raceadmin@flyracing.com or faxed in to 1-800-347-3589. Registration Forms must be filled out completely and legible. Be sure to indicate which class(s) you are participating in. Incomplete or unreadable Registration Forms will be discarded and not processed. It is up to the rider to follow up to make sure they are registered. If you supply an email address, you will receive a confirmation email when FLY Racing has received your completed registration form.

3. Riders that are competing in multiple classes must fill out three classes per Registration Form. If you enter more than 3 classes you will need to fill out another registration form. If you are participating in OTHER SERIES you must fill out the correct series registration form. Riders will ONLY be paid for registered classes. Must purchase 1 set of gear for every 1 registered classes and or entering for more than 1 series. For Example: Riding 3 classes in 1 series, rider must purchase 3 sets of gear and fill out 1 registration forms. If riding in 2 SERIES rider must fill out the correct registration form for EACH series and will need 1 SET of gear PER Series for a total of 2 sets.

Riders that duplicate, create fictitious, receipts and/or sign up for classes/series with the same receipt will be disqualified and banned from future programs. This is non negotiable and will not be tolerated.

4. ONLY after completed Registration Forms are received in the FLY office will a participant be eligible for the contingency program. FLY receiving date will be the official date you start accruing points.

### What you get

1. The FLY Racing/ASCS Contingency Program will pay points to registered riders finishing 1st thru 10th place Per Overall Class Finish. Points will not be awarded per moto, only overall class finish for the 2016 series. Points schedule is as follows:

1st Place = 20 Points	6th Place = 6 Points
2nd Place = 18 Points	7th Place = 5 Points
3rd Place = 16 Points	8th Place = 3 Points
4th Place = 15 Points	9th Place = 2 Points
5th Place = 14 Points	10th Place = 1 Points

Points earned will be tallied at the end of the series and converted to "FLY Bucks" at the rate of \$1 (retail) per point. A minimum number of riders must enter a class in order for points to be awarded thru 10th place. Points will be paid for up to 75% over all finish. In other words if 7 riders sign up for a class the points will be awarded for 1st thru 5th place. If 14 riders sign up for a class then points will be awarded for all 10 places. \*Minimum (5) riders to create a race day class\*

Riders who "work" the event and do not race will NOT receive FLY points or be paid out by FLY on credit/points given by ASCS.

2. All riders must meet the / FLY attendance and purchase requirements to be eligible for points.

3. Contingency certificates, "FLY Bucks", will be mailed to riders and must be redeemed in person to any Western Power Sports Dealer or directly through FLY Racing if there is no stocking dealer in the area. "FLY Bucks" are ONLY valid towards FLY product purchases. Payout is subject to promoter limitations or restrictions. "FLY Bucks" are based on manufactures retail price (msrp).

- Rider Registration.** In order to register for the Contingency Program racers need to fill out and return the Registration Form and must purchase one pant, one jersey, and one glove per class registered. Apparel must be from the **2017 FLY Racing Line** which consists of : Evolution Gear, Kinetic Gear, and Lite Hydrogen Gear in either Adult or Youth sizes. **\*Please note: Patrol & F-16 are not apart of the program any longer.**
- Contingency Payout.** The Contingency Program will pay points to registered riders finishing **1st thru 10th** place for each event in all classes in the 2017 series. **Points will be paid up to 75% of rider, up to 10th place, for each class.** Rider must meet series attendance requirements to be eligible for points or **NO LESS** than **50%** of the series scheduled events. Points schedule is as follows:

1st Place = 20 Points	6th Place = 6 Points
2nd Place = 18 Points	7th Place = 5 Points
3rd Place = 16 Points	8th Place = 3 Points
4th Place = 15 Points	9th Place = 2 Points
5th Place = 14 Points	10th Place = 1 Points
- Riders will **NOT** earn "FLY Bucks" UNTIL their registration form and receipt are received prior to race date. **\*IMPORTANT\* Make sure you fill out the correct registration form for the correct series. This is crucial!!** If a rider fails any of the above you will NOT receive FLY Bucks at the end of the season, and or get points credit for your winnings.
